In 2005, *rabble* launched the ever-expanding *rabble* podcast network ([www.rabble.ca/rpn](http://www.rabble.ca/rpn)) as well as the *rabble* book lounge complete with reviews, an online book store, book events listings and more ([www.rabble.ca/lounge](http://www.rabble.ca/lounge)), and in 2008 we launched *rabbletv*!

Since its inception in 2001, *rabble's* readership has grown by leaps and bounds while maintaining a loyal core readership: we have 250,000 monthly visitors who read more than eight million pages each month. *rabble.ca* is an incorporated not-for-profit organization.

- High level of responsibility, ability to meet deadlines and to work independently, and with accuracy and attention to detail
- Awareness of current affairs and of social justice movements
- Experience in working in a virtual environment preferable
